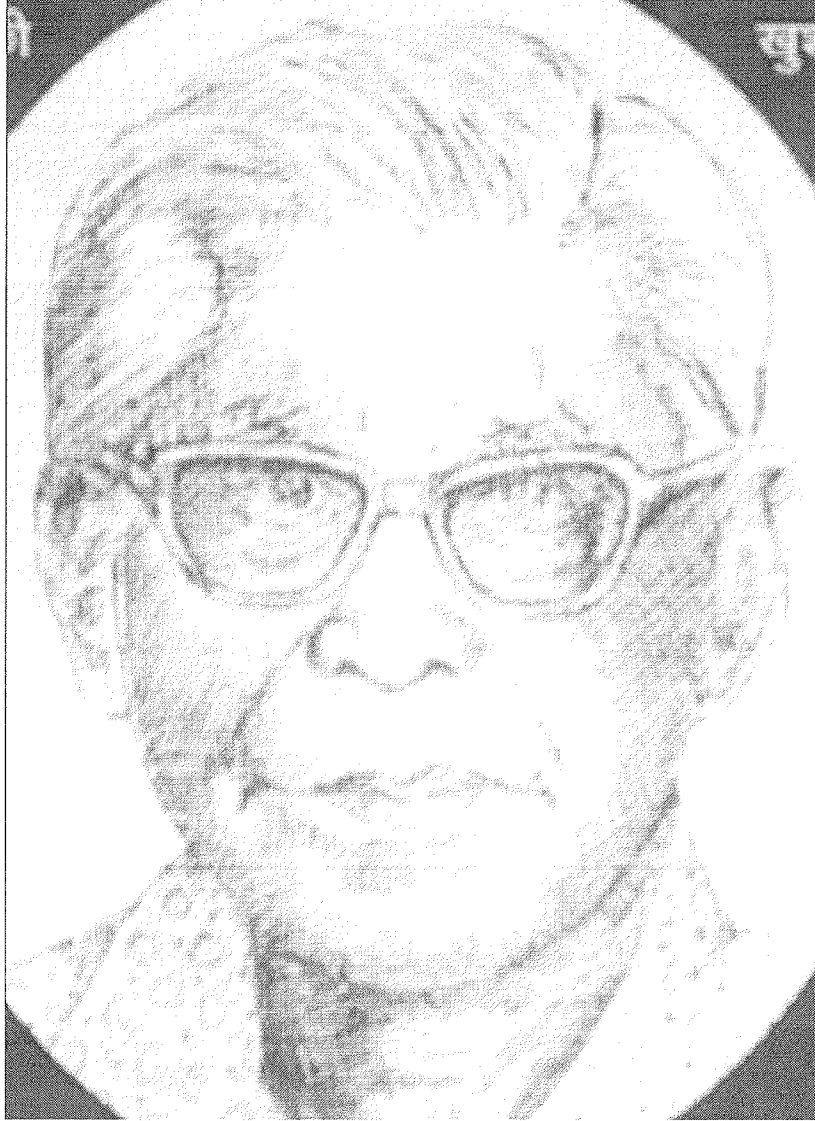
Editorial
